

Tobacco Greenhouse Soilless Media Test 2006

Ten soilless media entries and two types of trays were tested in 2006. All media were used directly from the bag without adding any water. Two types of trays (288 cell) were filled mechanically with a Berry Seeder filler box. One tray was a standard size tray (26.25" long x 13.25" wide x 2.5" deep) from Speedling Inc the other was a "shallow" tray (26.25" long x 13.25" wide x 1.5" deep) from Beltwide Inc. Trays were seeded with Rickard TN90 pelleted tobacco seed and floated in a randomized block design in a common float bay. Temperature was maintained between 68 to 82°F during germination. Germination and spiral roots were counted 2 weeks after seeding. Questions? Contact Bob Pearce at rpearce@uky.edu.
